SECURITY SCREENING OF FOREIGN DIRECTORS AND EMPLOYEES

The International Criminal Police (Interpol) has guided that with immediate effect, all foreign nationals seeking security clearance shall obtain security clearance certificates from their respective countries. In this regard, all foreign nationals proposed for appointment as director or employees of commercial banks and all other financial service providers shall be required to obtain Interpol clearance from their countries of origin. They would then submit the Interpol clearance certificate, together with the other required documents, to the Bank of Zambia.

All foreign nationals proposed for appointment as directors or employees of commercial banks and all other financial service providers who have lived in Zambia for over six months also require clearance from the Zambia Police Service.

Following these changes, the applicable security screening fees are:

Foreign Clearance
Amounts as determined by screening

authorities in different countries

Local clearance of foreigners - K50, 000.00 resident in Zambia

3. Clearance of Zambians - K50,000.00

Clearance of Zambians living - K477,400.00 outside the country
