#### PAYMENT OF ZAMBIA POLICE SECURITY SCREENING FEES

Notice is hereby given to all commercial banks and non-bank financial institutions that following the enactment of the Zambia Police (Clearance and Other Charges) Regulations 2006 (Statutory Instrument No 10 of 2006), which came into effect in January 2006, the cost of screening prospective directors and senior management staff of banks and tinancial institutions has been increased. The Statutory Instrument, a copy of which is attached, is available at Government printers for purchase.

This circular serves to inform all commercial banks and non-bank financial institutions that the cost of security screening which hitherto was being borne by the Bank of Zambia will. with immediate effect, be borne by the institutions applying for the clearance of directors or senior management staff.

The applicable clearance fees are K716,100.00 for non-Zambians outside the country, K477,400.00 for Zambians living abroad and K100,000 for local directors and senior staff.

Institutions applying for the screening of proposed director(s) or senior management staff will be required to write a cheque payable to the Bank of Zambia for the applicable fee. The cheque should be submitted to the Bank of Zambia at the time the prospective director(s) or senior management staff is called to present themselves to the Zambia Police Service for uplifting of fingerprints.

### STATUTORY INSTRUMENT NO. 10 OF 2006

The Zambia Police Act (Laws, Volume 8, Cap.107)

The Zambia Police (Clearance and Other Charges)
Regulations, 2006

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section sixty-ruo of the Zambia Police Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

 (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Zambia Police (Clearance and Other Charges) Regulations, 2006. Title

- (2) Any person requiring police clearance to be processed shall pay for the services as prescribed in the appendix to these Regulations.
- Fees for Police clearance and Other Charges
- (3) The money received under these Regulations shall be paid into the general revenues of the Republic.
- Money to be paid into the general revenues.
- 2. The Zambia Police (Non-Criminal Finger Prints Charges) Regulations are hereby revoked.
