Damaged or Mutilated Banknotes are banknotes that may be:-

- 1 Accidentally torn
- 2 Eaten by termites or rats
- 3 Burnt by fire
- 4 Decomposed from being buried or immersed in water
- 5 Have one piece missing
- 6 Or mutilated in any other way

Do you know that you can exchange your DAMAGED or MUTILATED BANKNOTES at the Bank of Zambia Head Office in Lusaka and Regional Office in Ndola?
