Setup Instructions for UploadHub Desktop App

Prerequisites
1. Install Python 3.9 or higher:
- Download Python from python.org.
- During installation, ensure you check the box for "Add Python to PATH."
2. Download and unzip the provided file:
- Save the unzipped folder to your preferred location on your computer.
Installation Steps
Open Command Prompt as Administrator:
- Right-click the Start Menu and select Windows PowerShell (Admin) or Command Prompt
(Admin).
2. Navigate to the unzipped folder:
cd path\to\unzipped\folder
3. Create a virtual environment:
python -m venv .venv
4. Activate the virtual environment:
.venv\Scripts\activate

5. Install required dependencies:
pip install -r requirements.txt
6. Run Django migrations:
python manage.py migrate
7. Start the Django server:
python manage.py runserver
8. Open a new Command Prompt window (keep the first one running):
- Navigate to the unzipped folder and activate the virtual environment again:
cd path\to\unzipped\folder
.venv\Scripts\activate
9. Build and run the desktop app:
pyinstaller desktop_launcher.spec
10. Navigate to the dist folder and run the app:
cd dist
UploadHub.exe
Troubleshooting
1. WebView2 Error:
- Download and install WebView2 Runtime from Microsoft's website.
2. "Port already in use" Error:

- Try changing the Django port:
python manage.py runserver 8080
- Update the URL in desktop_launcher.py to match the new port.
3. Command Prompt Windows:
- Ensure both Command Prompt windows stay open while using the app.

Notes

- The app requires an internet connection for the initial setup.
- Keep both the Django server and the desktop app running while using the application.
- To close the app properly:
 - 1. Close the desktop window first.
 - 2. Press Ctrl+C in both Command Prompt windows to stop the processes.
