Weed control



- Weed Control is the most important management strategy, reduces weed population to a level where you can make a living off of or enjoy using the land



Definition and description

- **Weed control** refers to those actions that seek to restrict the spread of weeds, and destroy or reduce their population in a given location.
- It is a required input in most crop production ventures as part of the routine management procedures.
- **Adequate control may also prevent future infestations.**
- There are four major control methods:
 - Preventive
 - Cultural / physical
 - Biological
 - Chemical
