

WHAT IS APA REFERENCING SKILLS?



What is APA?

- APA (American Psychological Association) Referencing Style is the official referencing style to do the references list and citations.
- There are many types of referencing styles such as Harvard Style, MLA Style and Chicago style. However, APA is the most widely used referencing style.

WHAT IS CITATIONS?

CITATIONS



- Citation refers to words or lines taken from a book or a speech (Oxford Advanced Learner's Dictionary, 2015).
- You should only state the reference which you have referred. For example, if you stated a statement in Oxford Advanced Learner's Dictionary (2015), the book should be cited in the reference list after the academic essay.

Citations

Teachers are expected to play a greater part in assessing students and use of valuable information to aid their instructions (Bailey, 2004). Cizek and Fitzgerald (1996) asserted that teachers are required to at least understand different purposes of different types of assessment, know how to construct appropriate and useful assessment as well as know how to accurately interpret and appropriately use assessment results.



NOW, DO YOUR CITATION.

Before the citation is done, you should take note that...

- The name of author should be changed to initial form.
E.g. H. Douglas Brown -> Brown, H. D.
Heekyeong Lee -> Lee, H.
- The first alphabet of book and proper noun in the book should be capitalised and the book name should be italicized.
E.g. *Teaching by principles: An interactive approach.*
- The edition of the book should be stated.
E.g. Fourth edition -> 4th ed.

So, the accepted citation is...

ESL Learners' reactions towards code switching in classroom settings

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Abstract

The use of more than one code of language among the Malaysian English language instructors and ESL learners in the context of formal classroom settings is widely acknowledged (Tuan & Ting, 2009). Many factors contribute to the occurrence of code-switching or in other words, there must have been certain communication purposes associated which cause code switching to occur. This study aims to uncover the attitudes of ESL learners towards the functions of code-switching employed by English language instructors at tertiary level. It addresses two research questions: (1) What do ESL learners think about code switching in the English classroom? (2) When does code switching best function in the English classroom for the ESL learners? Forty-five diploma students were randomly selected as the respondents for this study. A survey questionnaire which focused on the students' attitudes, usage and opinion towards code switching in the classroom was utilized in the study. It was found that most of the ESL learners have positive attitudes towards code switching. The ESL learners were also reported to believe that code switching facilitates them in understanding the target language. The findings suggest that the use of code switching is necessary when the situation requires the use of first language in the classroom to enable the learners to become more confident in mastering English.

- The name, volume and issue of journal should be italicised.
E.g. ... *Procedia – Social and Behavioral Sciences*, 90, ...
- Omit the title (Haji, Hajah, Dr.), 'bin' and 'binti' for Malay names.
E.g. Noli Maishara Nordin, Farrah Dieba Rashid Ali, Sharifah Intan Safina Syed Zubir, Roslan Sadjirin.

So, the accepted citation is...
