## Types of Prepositions

**Simple Preposition**    **Double Preposition**

When a preposition consists of one word is called single or simple preposition.    When a preposition consists of more than one word, it is called double preposition.

**Compound Preposition**    **Participle Preposition**

Compound preposition consists of two or more words.    Participle preposition consists of words that end in "ing".

**Disguised Prepositions**    **Phrase Prepositions**

'by' can be changed into 'be', 'on' into 'a', and 'of' can be changed into 'o' for example, 5 O' clock.    Group of words used with the force of a single preposition is called phrase preposition.

## TYPES OF ADJECTIVES

### ABSOLUTE ADJECTIVES

The absolute adjectives are the adjectives that cannot be compared.

### COMPARATIVE ADJECTIVES

They are the superlative degrees of the adjectives.

### POSSESSIVE ADJECTIVES

They are the possessive pronouns used as adjectives.



### SUPERLATIVE ADJECTIVES

Used to describe an object which is at the upper or lower limit.

### INDEFINITE ADJECTIVES

An indefinite adjective is an adjective formed from an indefinite pronoun.

### ATTRIBUTIVE ADJECTIVE

An Attributive adjective comes before a noun and not after a linking verb

## ADVERB AND IT'S TYPES

### Definition of Adverb

An adverb is a verb that describes a verb, an adjective or another adverb.

### Examples of Adverbs

- She is **very** beautiful. (Very is an Adverb)
- **Unfortunately**, he met an accident. (Unfortunately is an Adverb)
- He swims **well**.
- He ran **quickly**.

### Definition of Conjunction

A conjunction is a word that join words, phrases, clauses and sentences.

### Example

There are three major types of conjunctions:

- Coordinate Conjunction
- Subordinate Conjunction
- Correlative Conjunction

## CLAUSE AND IT'S TYPES

### Definition of Clause

A clause is a group of words that includes a subject and a verb. Sometimes, it forms a part of a sentence and sometime it makes a simple sentence by itself. A clause may function as a noun or as an adjective or as an adverb. If it functions as a noun, it is a noun clause. If it functions as an adjective, it is an adjective clause. And if it functions as an adverb, it is an adverb clause.

### Examples

- I graduated last year. (One clause sentence)
- When I came here, I saw him. (Two clause sentence)
- When I came here, I saw him, and he greeted me. (Three clause sentence)

## INTERJECTION AND ITS TYPES

### Interjection

Interjection is a word that expresses a strong feeling. It is just a sort of exclamation. Each Interjection has its own specific connotation. The listener of an Interjection instantly understands the emotions of the speaker.

### Example

- **Ah!**, that feels wonderful.
- **Alas!** I'm lost in the wilderness.
- **Boh!** That was a total waste of time.
- **Bless you!** I couldn't have done it without you.
- It's time for me to go. **Cheer!**
- **Congrats!**

## PRONOUN AND ITS TYPES

### DEFINITION OF PRONOUN

A pronoun is a word that is used instead of a noun. I, we, you, he, she, it, they, are pronouns.

### Examples

Alli is a good boy because **Alli** does his work in time. (Not suitable)  
Alli is a good boy because **he** does his work in time. (Suitable)

**Note:** In the second sentence we have used a pronoun (he) in place of a noun (Alli) which make our sentence look professional.

# 8 PARTS OF SPEECH

NOUN	PRONOUN	ADVERB	ADJECTIVE
A noun is used to name people, objects or ideas. Example Adnan is an intelligent young man.	A pronoun is used in place of a noun. Example I have built a house.	Refers to a word that describes a verb, an adjective, another adverb. Example I am going now.	An adjective is used to describe or qualify a noun. Example She is a <u>pretty</u> child.
PREPOSITION	VERB	CONJUNCTION	INTERJECTION
A preposition is used to show the relation of one thing to another. Example We went <u>about</u> the world.	A verb is used to describe an action. Example All <u>went</u> to Karachi	A conjunction is used to join words or group of words to one another. Example and, or, so, after, neither etc.	An interjection is used to express some sudden rush of feeling or excitement. Example <u>Alas!</u> we have lost the match.
